Evansville - Nancy Swope Glackman, 88, of Evansville went to heaven on Tuesday, June 30th surrounded by her loving family and her devoted husband, Gene, after a brief hospitalization. She was born in McCutchanville, Indiana on September 17, 1931 to Ralph and Margaret Swope. A graduate of Reitz High School class of 1949, she attended Evansville College prior to her marriage.
