On Kansas Road in McCutchanville, Indiana

Does a church own the cemetery?

No. Neither the McCutchanville Methodist Church nor the McJohnston Chapel own the cemetery.

Who is in charge of the cemetery?

Anyone that owns a plot or has a family member in the cemetery is considered a board member. From the board, there are nine directors that are in charge of the cemetery.

How much are the burial plots?

Refer to the minutes or contact the Secretary/Trasurer. The phone number and a link to the minutes are on the front page of the website.

How do I buy a burial plot?

To purchase a burial plot, contact the Secretary/Treasurer.

That phone number is on the front page of the website.

Who do I contact to place a stone?

Contact the Secretary/Treasurer to have a stone placed.

That phone number is on the front page of the website.

Who opens and closes the grave?

Contact the Secretary/Treasurer to have a grave opened/closed.

That phone number is on the front page of the website.

How are the cemetery directors selected?

The nine directors are selected from owners or family members of plots in the cemetery.

How can I become a cemetery director?

At an annual meeting, a person would be nominated from the board by a current cemetery director and then the current directors would vote.

Can I come to the meeting if I'm not a director?

Anyone owning a plot or with a family member in the cemetery is welcome to attend the annual meeting. Meetings are open to the public.
